**EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION AND ACOLYTE  
ONGOING FORMATION DAYS**

As part of the ongoing formation requirement for all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Acolytes, the Pastoral Office will present five half day seminars around the Diocese. The focus for this year's seminar will be Pope Francis' Call to Holiness in daily life and how this relates to liturgical ministry. In addition, basic and practical issues in the exercise of these ministries will be addressed during the day. Attendance at one of these seminars will fulfil the minister's ongoing formation obligation for one calendar year. Today, Pentecost Sunday, we hear about the risen Christ appearing to the disciples who are huddled behind locked doors. He offers the simple greeting: "Peace be with you," the greeting we offer each other at every Eucharistic celebration. He sends them on a mission of peace in continuity with his own God-inspired mission. He breathes on them the gift of the Holy Spirit and tells them that God will forgive those whom they forgive, and will "retain" the transgressions of those whose sins or transgressions they "retain". The Holy Spirit is the unique source of our power to forgive, of our capacity to deal with the perpetrators of violence, and of the strength we need to refrain from vengeance. We must work ceaselessly as a global community to address the causes of violence and abuse and search together for lasting solutions. As we celebrate Pentecost Sunday, let us gather into our hearts all the distressed members of our Earth community and pray with greater urgency than ever: **"Come Holy Spirit, renew the face of the Earth"**

As announced earlier in the year, there is to be a diocesan synod in 2019 after a twelve month period of consultation across the Bunbury Diocese. It is hoped that every parishioner will participate in this process, giving his or her views on the future direction of the Bunbury Diocese. The synod will be coordinated with the 2020 Australian Plenary Council. On Sunday, 2 June, the Bishop will be holding a meeting for all interested in synod process to explain its process. The meeting will be an opportunity for those attending to share their hopes and dreams with the Bishop, as well as to offer their thoughts and suggestions. The Meeting will be held in the **Narrogin parish hall and start at 2pm.**
